Residential – Single Family

**Davidson House**

Located on a wooded lot, this new structure provides a rural lifestyle within walking distance of historic downtown Davidson. Incorporating a modern take on the classic Southern screened porch, Brendon Farrell took this project from design through permit and completion with regular site visits.

**Saide Residence**

Modern with local vernacular touches, this new home and guesthouse was designed to provide privacy without losing connections to landscape and light. Brian Boyle Architect took the project through design, permit and construction; Brendon Farrell was project lead on design and construction documentation, including custom casework, fixture integration and exterior detail coordination.

**Private Residence**

Designed with literal historic reference, this new residence was an addition to and remodel of an existing structure. Due to privacy, images are not available. The adjacent image is an H.H. Richardson building used as precedent. At Colab Architecture+Design, Brendon Farrell was project architect. He developed design, construction and permit documentation with weekly construction meeting attendance through completion.

**Ali Wai Condominiums**

This new 38-story condominium building was designed, taken through city approval and construction documentation by Guerin Glass Architects with ongoing consultation between Hawaiian architects of record. Brendon Farrell developed the building enclosure, vertical circulation, mechanical, electrical, plumbing coordination and managed the building and parking garage structural coordination.

**Trump International Condominiums**

This new 38-story condominium hotel was designed, taken through city approval and construction documentation by Guerin Glass Architects with ongoing consultation between Hawaiian architects of record. A program of the Oregon Sustainable Agricultural Land Trust to promote food production and education in the urban environment, the Urban Grange provides a location for gathering and a teaching kitchen in proximity of community and OSALT gardens. Brendon Farrell developed the program proposal and visualization for community development.

**New Bronx Criminal Courthouse**

At Rafael Vinoly Architects, Brendon Farrell spent two years developing design and construction documents for the New Bronx Criminal Courthouse, a project estimated to take 17 years for completion. In particular, he oversaw design, construction and bid documentation/ qualified bid review/ structural coordination on a \$35 million custom, unitized, blast-resistant, glass curtain wall system and building enclosure.

Loyly is a new commercial sauna, steam and massage facility. Brendon Farrell reviewed lease and broker negotiations, developed design, construction and permit documentation with furniture and fixture packages prepared for client review and purchase. Site meetings were attended at regular intervals with constant documentation and correspondence maintained through completion.
